Are you a researcher interested in exploring entrepreneurship, or are you considering an innovative idea that you want to transform into a new business?

Our interrelated programmes [EnterpriseTECH](#) and [EnterpriseTECH STAR](#) are designed for individuals like you. Both 10-week programmes run in extracurricular mode, so you can fit them around your studies, research or day job. You don't have to be at Cambridge to join us.

EnterpriseTECH: No business idea? No problem.

[EnterpriseTECH](#) is an immersive learning experience shared with 60 people (per cohort) from a range of research backgrounds.

By way of an intensive four-day lecture series, hands-on workshops, supervisions, and practical application to real-world projects, we help you build versatile entrepreneurship skills and valuable enterprise networks, enabling you to thrive in today's entrepreneurial landscape.

The programme runs twice each academic year. Entry is by online application and informal interview. You don't need your own business idea to join us or prior business knowledge and you'll work as part of a team and learn together.

The early-stage technologies selected as commercial feasibility projects for teams to work on are usually STEM-focussed (areas suited to our cohorts). You can see titles of some of our past projects [here](#).

EnterpriseTECH STAR: Progress your business idea

[EnterpriseTECH STAR](#), launched in 2019 is designed for (up to 20) EnterpriseTECH alumni seeking to turn research or ideas into businesses aligned with [UK Research & Innovation](#) missions.

Presented every 18-24 months, the programme involves interactive talks, workshops, and tasks that run on alternate weeks. You will also get personalised mentoring with experienced coaches who will help you develop professionally and personally as an individual and entrepreneur.

The programme helps you build a first narrative around your business idea, flesh out the substance and details, and prepare for applying to accelerators, competitions or pre-seed funding. You can read about the experiences of our alumni who founded numerous companies [here](#).
